

A REMINDER...

When batteries become exhausted, the chances of their leaking and damaging the interior of your hearing aid are greatly increased. Occasionally, however, even *new* batteries may leak because of slight imperfections in manufacture.

Always play safe by removing the battery from your aid each night and checking carefully for any sign of leakage.

If traces of chemical are discovered, discard the battery and immediately wipe the battery compartment and contacts with a cloth or small brush dampened in household ammonia. This will prevent corrosion and resulting noisy and inefficient operation.
